

CASIO 130 CR

OPERATION MANUAL

Ensure register dial is turned to REG mode

1. MAKING A SALE:

Enter the price of the item without decimal point

Press the department the item belongs to.

Repeat the above 2 steps to enter more items.

Press SUBTOTAL for the total amount due

Enter amount of cash given by customer and press the CA/ AMT TEND key.

If the customer is paying by cheque or eftpos then instead of pressing CASH press CH (for Eftpos or Credit Card) or CHK (for cheque).

The amount of change to be given to the customer will display on the screen and receipt/ journal.

2. MULTIPLE TENDER

This is used when a customer is paying by more than one method, e.g. part cash, part eftpos.

First enter the amount to be paid by cash

Press the CA key

This will tell you the outstanding balance to be paid by another method.

Press the key corresponding to that method of payment, e.g. EFTPOS (CH)

3. MAKING CORRECTIONS TO A TRANSACTION:

To clear the last transaction (before the subtotal key is entered) press the ERR/CORRECT key.

To delete an amount after pressing the SUBTOTAL key, enter the amount to be refunded then press the – key.

4. REFUNDS:

To refund items after a sale has been completed, you can turn the dial to RF mode then enter the items as you normally would to process a sale.

Once the transaction is completed it is important to turn the dial back to REG mode, if it isn't then all further transactions will be processed as a refund until the key is returned to REG.

5. TO GIVE A % DISCOUNT (e.g. 15%):

Enter the price of the item then press the department the item belongs to.

Enter the amount to be discounted (e.g. 15)

Press the % key. This will display the dollar amount that has been discounted

Press the SUBTOTAL key and this will display total amount due

6. TO GIVE A \$ DISCOUNT (eg \$5)

Enter the price of the item then press the department the item belongs to.

Enter the amount to be discounted and press the – key.

This will display the dollar amount that has been discounted

Press the SUBTOTAL key this will display the total amount due

7. EFTPOS CASH OUT:

Must be on a separate transaction
Enter the amount of cash to be given out
Press the PO key

8. EXPLANATION OF CORRECTION KEYS:

ERROR CORRECT

Used to take off last item before CASH key has been pressed. Only takes off last sale item.

CANCEL

Cancels whole transaction.

%

Used to register a % off discount. Enter amount then press % key.

MINUS KEY (-)

Used to register dollar discounts. Enter \$ amount then – key

PO

Used to enter cash out sales. Enter amount and press CASH OUT key, is made separately from a sale transaction

C- Clear the screen

9. CHANGING THE DATE AND TIME

TIME

Turn the dial to PGM position

Press 1 then sub total (P should appear in the display)

In 24hr format enter the time e.g. if it is 1:18pm enter 1318

Press time/date button

Press AC/C to exit the function

DATE

Turn the dial to PGM position

Press 1 then sub total (P should appear in the display)

Enter the date in the following format: yymmdd e.g. to set the date 08/01/04 you would enter 040108 (year-month-day)

Press date/time

Press AC/C to exit function

Turn the dial back to REG

10. ENTERING UNIT PRICE FOR DEPARTMENTS:

To enter prices against each department key turn the dial to the PGM position

Enter 1

Press the SUBTOTAL key

Enter the price for the first department (without the decimal point)

Press 1 (for department 1)

Enter the price for the second department (without the decimal point)

Press 2 (for department 2) etc

Press the SUBTOTAL key when all departments are programmed

11. CHANGING THE PAPER

Remove the printer cover

Put a roll of paper into the journal holder; make sure the roll is feeding from the bottom.

Cut the end of the paper straight with scissors and insert the paper into the feed slot (above the battery compartment).

Press FEED till the paper feeds through about 20-30cm

For Receipt function

Feed the paper through the slot in the printer cover and replace the printer cover.

For Journal function

If you are using a journal, remove the flat end of the spool and feed the paper into the centre of the spool ensuring the flat end of the spool is to the left.

Wind over and back until the paper holds firm.

Place the spool in the spool holder and close the printer cover.

RECEIPT/ JOURNAL FUNCTION

Your register can be used in either the receipt or journal mode, a receipt can be issued with each transaction or you may log all your transactions to a journal.

Note- the journal function uses less paper whilst the receipt mode gives your customer a record of their transaction.

You must have a roll of paper in your register at all times.

Your register comes set to receipt mode

To change to Journal mode

Turn the dial to the PGM position

Press 0 then CH

Press SUB TOTAL to end the function

Return the dial to the REG position

To change to Receipt mode

Turn the dial to the PGM position

Press 1 then CH

Press SUB TOTAL to end the function

Return the dial to the REG position

THE 'RA' KEY

Your register has a 'received on account' function, this is labeled RA. This function is rarely used but enables you to put money in the register without it showing as 'takings' for the day. The total taken whilst using this function will be shown on your Z report.

12. REPORTS

Be sure to perform the Z report at the end of each business day, otherwise, you will not be able to distinguish between the sales data for different dates. An X report will give you the same information as below but will not reset the totals for the day.
